

Youth Ministry Code of Conduct

Participation in the organization's programs is subject to the observance of the organization's rules and procedures. *The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited*. Any participant who violates this Code is subject to warnings where appropriate, and discipline, up to and including removal from the program. If behavior is repeated, the participant may be asked not to attend future events.

- Abusive language towards a staff member, volunteer or another participant.
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs at an event or reporting to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Bringing dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items.
- Verbal, physical or online harassment of another participant, staff member or volunteer.
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to follow Church policy or procedure.
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.
- Failure to cooperate with an adult supervisor/leader/mentor.
